### **About Centre for One Health**

The Department of Veterinary Public Health and Epidemiology was established in 1984 and upgraded to School of Public Health and Zoonoses (SPHZ) in 2012 and then to Centre for One Health in 2021. The prime mandates of the Centre are teaching, research and extension activities in the field of zoonoses, milk and meat hygiene, food safety, environmental hygiene and epidemiology.

The Centre is working with many prestigious research agencies, including, DBT, UGC, Gates Foundation, ICAR, ICMR in projects on Zoonoses, Food Safety and Environmental Health.

Please assign the serial number of the theme under which you intend to present your work. The institutional details of the authors should be clearly mentioned with the complete detail of the corresponding author. Only single entry is allowed for the presenting author in each theme. Fifteen abstracts will be selected from each theme by the expert committee (05 for oral presentation and 10 for poster presentation). The selected abstracts will be invited for oral presentation or poster presentation during the conference sessions. Two best oral and three best poster presentations will be selected for the award from each session.
